PUBLIC HEARING, Discussion and Possible Action Regarding the Joseph Road Reconstruction Project [Wagner]

BACKGROUND:

The City of Pewaukee previously bid this project as a Road Reconstruction and Utility Extension project. After several iterations, the utility extension was removed. This project is a road reconstruction project only. All previously purchased items which can be used in the 2024 construction have been included in the new project as costs to the contract along with previous engineering costs.

Joseph Road is in pour condition and requires reconstruction. The project was bid to remove the existing asphalt and stone base, correct any subgrade instability, install new stone base, add curb and gutter, and place asphaltic concrete. As you may recall from a previous Council meeting, we increased the width of this roadway to accommodate the truck turning movements required by the existing loading dock locations.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

The 2024 budget allocated \$390,000 from the Storm Water Utility and \$500,000 from the City Road Fund.

The total project cost including previous and current engineering, administration, and contingencies is \$926,246.93. The allocation to each budget component is \$391,372.99 for the Storm Water Utility and \$534,873.94 for the City Road Fund. The exceedance of the budget is due to the previous engineering costs related to the prior bidding and design of this project.

If needed, reallocate road funds up to \$35,000 from the Shady Lane/Shady Nook Road project to Joseph Road project.

RECOMMENDED MOTION:

Common Council award the Joseph Road Reconstruction Contract to the lowest qualified bidder, All-ways Contractors, Inc. in the amount of \$578,480.23 and accept the preliminary engineers report, special assessments, and reallocate road funds as noted.

Schedule "A" - Joseph Road

The City of Pewaukee is considering the pavement rehabilitation of Joseph Road. The improvements consist of road reconstruction, curb installation, drainage improvements, and related facilities.

The cost of road improvements will be apportioned to all property owners abutting the street with direct or indirect access. All non-residential properties shall pay the full road assessment.

The cost of 50% of the curb installations will be apportioned to all property owners abutting the street with direct or indirect access. All non-residential properties shall pay the full separate curb assessment.

Inlet installations, drainage improvements, and 50% of the curb installations will be paid by the Storm Water Management Utility.

It is recommended that the costs for curb installations and road improvements will be determined on a per-access basis.

We reviewed the documentation submitted by the apparent low bidder and found that:

- 1. The Bid Form has been appropriately completed.
- 2. We have no objections to the low bidder, nor to the proposed major subcontractors and suppliers.
- 3. Low bidder has successfully completed similar projects over the last several years.

On these bases, we recommend that All-Ways Contractors, Inc. be awarded the Joseph Road Reconstruction contract, in the amount of \$578,480.23. This amount is based on the bid unit prices and estimated quantities. Actual quantities, and therefore the final contract price, may vary. On all construction projects, unpredictable factors may increase the final contract amount. For this reason, we recommend that the City of Pewaukee include a 10 percent contingency when preparing the financial plan for this work.

Our review did not include an evaluation of bidder's current financial condition nor of their permanent safety program.

Should you decide to accept our recommendation, we have prepared the enclosed Notice of Award for your use. After City approval has been received, please have the appropriate official sign where indicated and forward a signed copy of the Notice of Award to our office. We will then fill in the date at the top of page one and forward it, with contracts for execution, to the Contractor. One fully completed Notice of Award will be returned to you for your records.

Bids remain subject to acceptance until March 18, 2024, unless Bidder agrees to an extension. Please advise us of your award decision, or call if there are any questions.

Discussion and Possible Action Regarding We Energies Request for an Easement on City Property with Tax Key PWC 0912-982-002 [Wagner]

BACKGROUND:

We Energies has requested an easement on the City owned parcel PWC 0912982002 for the purpose of burying their overhead lines in the area. This parcel has our Hill n Dale Pond which was completed in late 2023. The easement will not disrupt the pond, its outfall, or its berm. Additional language was added to ensure the access in the dry pond or its berms will not be allowed without explicit permission from the City (barring an emergency) to protect the pond and its operation.

The easement is also adjacent to our future location of sanitary sewer and water main extension. We Energies has agreed to pay if their utility needs to be moved to accommodate these extensions one time within the easement agreement.

The easements are directly to adjacent to the existing homes for the majority of the route. The widths vary but do not exceed 12 feet.

We do not anticipate any conflicts with their facility and are recommending approval of the easement contingent on approval from the City Engineer and City Attorney.

- 1. Purpose: The purpose of this easement is to construct, install, operate, maintain, repair, replace and extend underground utility facilities, conduit and cables, electric pad-mounted transformers, concrete slabs, power pedestals, riser equipment, terminals and markers, together with all necessary and appurtenant equipment under and above ground as deemed necessary by Grantee, all to transmit electric energy, signals, television and telecommunication services, including the customary growth and replacement thereof. Trees, bushes, branches and roots may be trimmed or removed so as not to interfere with Grantee's use of the easement area.
- 2. Access: Grantee or its agents shall have the right to enter and use Grantor's land with full right of ingress and egress over and across the easement area and adjacent lands of Grantor for the purpose of exercising its rights in the easement area. 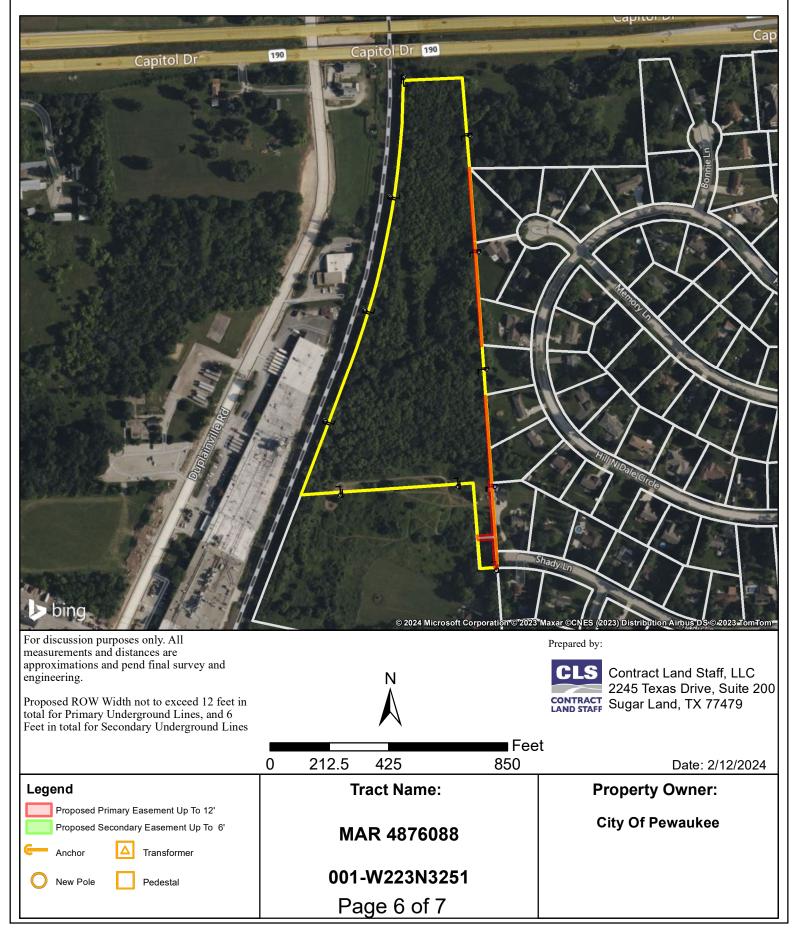
