In attendance: Commissioner Kathleen Novack, Commissioner Elaine Kroening and Commissioner Thomas Farley. Also present were Chief Bierce, AC Hoppe and Rita Skebba

- 1.0 Pledge of Allegiance and Moment of Silence [Novack]
 - 1.1. Call to Order Commissioner Novack called the meeting to order at 4:01pm
 - 1.2. Roll Call
- 2.0 Public comments: None
- 3.0 Discussion and Possible Action regarding the Meeting Minutes of March 8th, 2018: <u>A motion</u> <u>was made and seconded, (E. Kroening, T. Farley) to approve the minutes of March 8th,</u> <u>2018.</u> Motion passed : 3-For 0-Against
- 4.0 Discussion and Possible Action regarding the Full-Time Firefighter Hiring Process: Chief Bierce stated that we are in the process of hiring four full-time firefighters this year. Fifteen applicants have applied and the applications have not yet been screened for qualifications. Chief Bierce stated he would like to make a list from this hiring process and keep that list good for a year. Chief Bierce stated that the number of candidates have dropped dramatically. Commissioner Kroening asked how we could get more candidates to apply without lowering the qualifications that we require now. AC Hoppe stated that maybe we could drop the MPO requirement and have them get it at a later date. Chief Bierce stated that he would like the hiring process to include a written exam, an individual profile and three interview panels consisting of ems panel, training panel and administration panel. He stated that the scores from this process would then be brought to the Fire Commission so they can interview the top candidates. Commissioner Farley asked how this would be scored. Chief Bierce stated that they would receive a score from each of the three processes and then those scores would be totaled. Commissioner Novack asked Chief Bierce what a passing score on the written test would be. Chief Bierce replied that a score of 70% or hirer would be passing. Chief Bierce stated that he will start the process right away and hopes to have the tests results to the Fire Commission sometime in June so they can interview the candidates.
- 5.0 Closed Session Adjourn Into Closed Session You are hereby notified that the Fire Commission will immediately convene into closed session upon motion duly made and seconded and acted upon by roll-call vote as required under §19.85(1)(a), Stats. The Fire Commission along with City staff will attend the closed session. The purpose of the closed session is for the following:
 - For considering employment, promotion, compensation or performance evaluation data of any public employee over which the governmental body has jurisdiction or exercises responsibility as authorized under Section 19.85(1) (c), Wisconsin Statutes, specifically with regard to the Deputy Chief of Training position.

Re-Convene to Open Session: Commissioner Novack called for a roll-call vote to re-convene into Open Session. <u>All members voted in favor of re-convening and the meeting was now</u> <u>in Open Session at 4:40pm. Commissioner Farley made a motion, seconded by</u> <u>Commissioner Kroening to hire Dave Johnsen as the new Deputy Chief of Training for</u> <u>the Pewaukee Fire Department.</u> The motion passed 3-For 0-Against.
